About Shanghai Summer

This summer, the Shanghai Municipal People's Government plans to launch a new IP for summer consumption promotion activities in the city - "Shanghai Summer" International Consumption Season, which will feature more than 60 high-quality and high-capacity concerts, music festivals, cultural and art performances, and major sports events with a high tourist flow, and a number of service initiatives that reflect Shanghai's internationalized and top-quality consumption environment will be launched to attract global travelers to come to Shanghai, experience and enjoy the city.



Welcome to Shanghai

Shanghai, a municipality directly under the central government of China, is a modern international metropolis with a spirit of inclusiveness, pursuit of excellence, broad-mindedness, and humility.

Located at the estuary of the Yangtze River in East China and facing the Pacific Ocean, Shanghai forms part of the Yangtze River Delta, one of China's most robust, open and innovative regions.

As China's largest economic powerhouse and an important international financial center, Shanghai achieved a GDP of 4.72 trillion yuan in 2023, up 5 percent year-on-year.

Shanghai is also a leading international trade and consumption center, with its ports' total throughput the highest in the world. In 2023, Shanghai's total imports and exports amounted to 4.21 trillion yuan, marking a record high, while the city's total retail sales of consumer goods surged by 12.6 percent.

Shanghai is an important global shipping center and an open hub, implementing the RCEP (Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership) agreement and accelerating the construction of the Waigaoqiao and Hongqiao national import trade promotion and innovation demonstration zones.

The city is also making significant progress in building an international science and technology innovation center. The proportion of research and development expenditure to the GDP was around 4.4 percent in 2023, while the number of high-value invention patents per 10,000 people was up to 50.2.

Shanghai is developing toward an internationally influential digital city, strengthening the foundational support for urban digital transformation.

It is one of the country's most international cities, with 962 headquarters of multinational companies and 561 foreign-invested R&D centers established by the end of 2023.

Shanghai is also a world-renowned cultural metropolis and international travel destination, with 239 public libraries, 165 museums and 100 art galleries by the end of 2023.

Shanghai aims to enhance its urban soft power to match its ambition to become a socialist metropolis with global influence. In the future, Shanghai will showcase its character of "International, Innovative and Inclusive", focus on high-quality development, and turn itself into an international economic, financial, trade, shipping, and science and technology innovation center, as well as a global digital city with great influence.

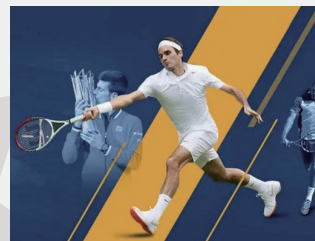

ATP World Tour Masters 1000

The ATP World Tour Masters 1000 is a series of tournaments on the ATP World Tour, often referred to as the "ATP 1000 Masters" or simply "ATP Masters." Comprising nine events across Europe, North America, and Asia (starting from 2009), these tournaments are significant for top male tennis players, ranking second in importance only to the four Grand Slams and the ATP World Tour Finals. The ATP World Tour Masters 1000 offers players more prize money and ranking points than standard competitions.

Most of the finals in this series were best-of-five matches until 2007, but since 2008, all matches have been best-of-three. With the exception of the Monte Carlo Rolex Masters, the other eight Masters tournaments are mandatory for top-ranked players.

Bank Card Payment

Cards issued in your home country/region can be accepted if logos of UnionPay, Visa, Mastercard and other payment organizations are displayed at the checkout counter (see picture below). If not, please ask the cashier whether your card is accepted. If you hold a UnionPay card issued outside China's mainland, it can be accepted by any merchant POS terminal in China's mainland.

Cash Payment

If you want to pay in cash, there are two main ways to obtain RMB cash.

01 Cash Withdrawal

You can withdraw RMB by your bank card at an ATM or CRS with corresponding international payment network logos (see pictures below).



Cash withdrawal using UnionPay cards is supported by all ATMs and CRSs in Shanghai.

02 Currency Exchange

If you need cash, you can also directly exchange at bank outlets with currency exchange signs, outlets of qualified financial institutions or self-service kiosks. Please consult the staff for currencies available.

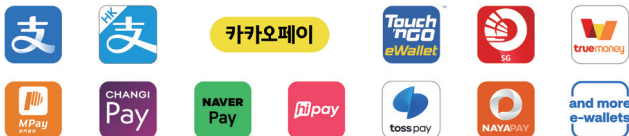

When shopping at merchants in the Chinese mainland (except for special occasions), if you have AlipayHK, Kakao Pay, Touch'n Go eWallet, OCBC, TrueMoney, MPay, Changi Pay, NAVER Pay, Toss Pay, Hipay or other Alipay+ partner e-wallet on your phone, just open it and pay directly once you see



● Bind overseas bank card with Alipay and scan to pay



After downloading the Alipay app, signing up, and linking an overseas bank card of major card networks, overseas travelers can start their mobile payment journey in China and pay like a local.

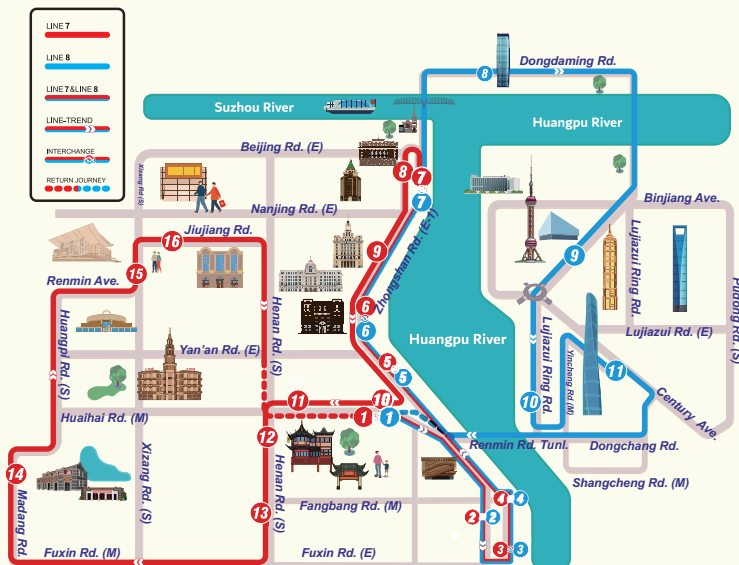

"Go out and call Qiangsheng Taxi, a familiar ride in Shanghai." For taxi booking, please dial the Qiangsheng service hotline at 62580000 one day in advance. For English assistance, press "5" after the call is connected. Upon successful booking, priority will be given to arranging a driver known for excellent service quality.



Shanghai Metro



Starting from April 15th, all service centers at Shanghai Metro stations will accept foreign banking cards for ticket purchases.

To foster a business-friendly environment and encourage the utilization of international card payment services within the rail transport sector, Shanghai Metro has enhanced its acceptance of both domestic and international bank cards on the existing maglev line and at four airport stations. Starting from April 15, 2024, service centers at all subway stations throughout the network will be outfitted with POS terminals to facilitate the purchase of subway tickets using domestic and international cards via assisted service.

Scope of Acceptance for Domestic and International Bank Card Payments

- 01 **Acceptance point:** All network station service centers
- 02 **Types of tickets available include** single one-way tickets, one-day and three-day metro passes. Select stations also offer metro-maglev single-journey combo tickets and metro-maglev round-trip combo tickets
- 03 **The following bank cards are accepted:**
 - a) International cards: Visa, MasterCard, Discover Card, American Express, Diners Club, JCB.
 - b) Domestic card: China UnionPay.

Tips 2- Direct Debit Service for Shanghai Public Transportation: The “Shanghai Transport Code” is a QR code designed for convenient travel on buses, ferries, and other public transportation options throughout Shanghai. Passengers can effortlessly access public transportation by presenting their ride code to the scanning device, eliminating the necessity for advance payment. This “ride first, pay later” service offers a seamless travel experience.

02 NFC Mobile Transportation Card

Tips 1- Platform: Shanghai Public Transportation APP

Tips 2- Mobile Transport Card Recharging: Activate your NFC-enabled mobile traffic card and launch the Shanghai Traffic Card app. Navigate to the [Home] page, tap [Recharge], and choose either WeChat or Alipay for payment, linking it to your foreign currency card. Follow the prompts to complete the top-up with ease.

03 Physical Traffic Card

Recharging location: Offline CVM machines

Choose either WeChat or Alipay as your payment platform, linked to your international currency card. Then, position the payment QR code within the scan area to top up the physical card.

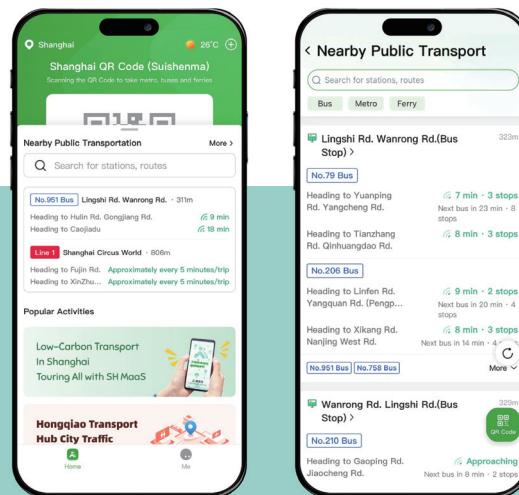

SH MaaS APP English Version unveils its new “Real-Time Bus” tracking feature

To further enhance the convenience of public transportation services for foreign nationals, the English version of the Shanghai “Mobility as a Service” (MaaS) platform, SH MaaS, has launched a “Real-Time Bus” information inquiry service.



Foreign travelers and expatriates in Shanghai can access real-time transit information for the metro, buses, and ferries through the SH MaaS app. Additionally, they can use the “SH MaaS Code” (Shanghai Transport Code) and “One-Code Access” for seamless access and enjoy the same discounts as local residents.

The SH MaaS app now supports multiple payment channels including Alipay, Wexin Pay, and UnionPay.

For binding international cards with app payments, if users have already linked their international cards with Alipay, Wexin Pay, or UnionPay, they can directly use the “One-Code Access” service through the SH MaaS app.

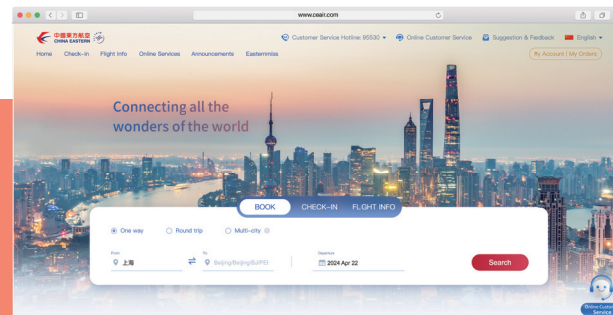

- ① Make purchase in TFS stores.
- ② Ask for a Tax Refund Application Form and VAT invoice.

Step 2- Stamp:

- ① Before check-in luggage, please go to the customs, present your VAT invoice(s) along with the Tax Refund Application Form(s), a valid passport or ID and the purchased goods.
- ② Get the customs stamp on your Tax Refund Application Form(s).

Step 3- Claim:

- ① After security, please present your valid personal passport or ID, and stamped Tax Refund Application Form(s) to get your refund.
- ② If the refund amount does not exceed RMB10,000, you can choose either a cash or a credit card refund. If the refund amount exceeds RMB10,000, you can only choose credit card refund.

Xujiahui Sports Park

Situated in the heart of Xuhui District and spanning 35.96 hectares, Xujiahui Sports Park features key facilities including the Shanghai Stadium, Shanghai Gymnasium, Shanghai Swimming Pool, and the Comprehensive Hall. It stands as one of Shanghai's most fully-equipped areas for sports and culture, and proudly hosts the Chinese Football Association Super League and the Chinese Basketball Association's Men's Professional League as their shared home grounds.



Huangpu Riverside Skateboard Extreme Park

The Park is situated at No.1 Dock in the Huangpu River Expo Park, spanning nearly 10,000 square meters. Out of this, the skateboarding competition zone occupies over 3,000 square meters. It was expertly crafted by the design team responsible for the Tokyo Olympic Skateboarding venue, making it the most expansive skateboarding-themed park within the central districts of the global major cities.



The Yaoxue Ice and Snow World

The Yaoxue Ice and Snow World project, situated in the 101 Core Area of Lin-gang Special Area of China (Shanghai) Pilot Free Trade Zone, strives to establish a premier, one-stop urban ice and snow resort that stands as the largest indoor ski destination globally. The Shanghai Sports Museum

In addition, there is an entrance hall and a space for temporary exhibits. The museum boasts a collection of 4,900 sets and 8,334 individual pieces. Interactive offerings include VR experiences, film screenings, multidimensional space exhibits, trivia quizzes, tactile sand table displays, and sports information services. Guests are invited to immerse themselves in the evolution and culture of Shanghai's sporting history through engaging visual, auditory, and tactile encounters.



The Shanghai Sports Show



From November 28 to 30, the Shanghai Sports Show will be held at the Shanghai World Expo Exhibition and Convention Center. It is the first large-scale sports expo in China that integrates sports events, sports culture, sports industry, and sports consumption.



Yuanshen Sports Center

Situated in the Pudong Lujiazui Financial and Trade Zone, the Yuanshen Gymnasium stands as a multifaceted public sports complex designed like a park within the Pudong New Area. This newly constructed sports facility was crafted for the Special Olympics and spans an area of roughly 35,000 square meters, featuring both a gymnasium and a swimming pool. It incorporates an array of energy-efficient designs while showcasing a stunning architectural aesthetic of "three-sided transparency" and a "celestial circle on an earthly square".

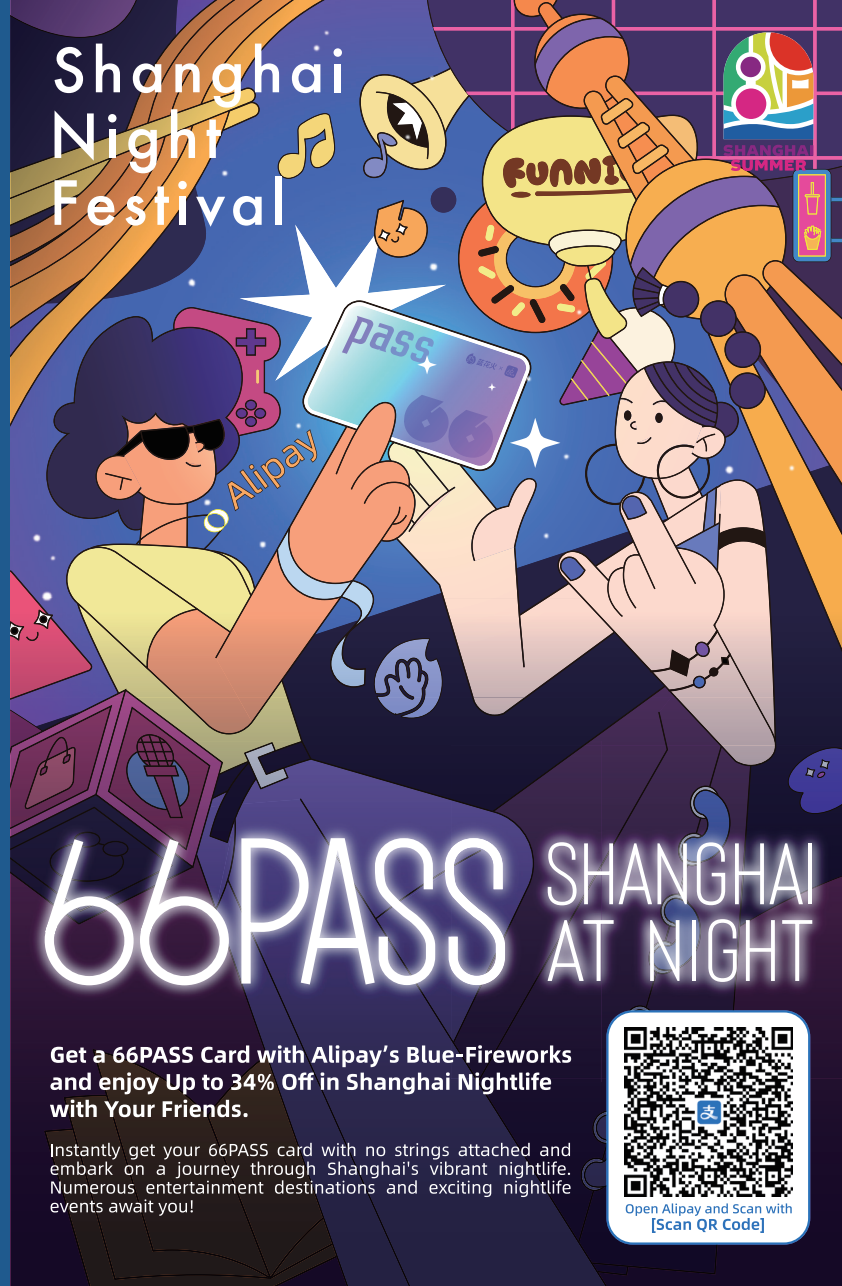
